Summary

On the Summary page of the patient's record, there are different viewing options on the ribbon



Consultation

This will display all consultations. The Date Navigator displays on the left. To filter consultations click **Search View** and search by word or you can create your own views using the filter arrow

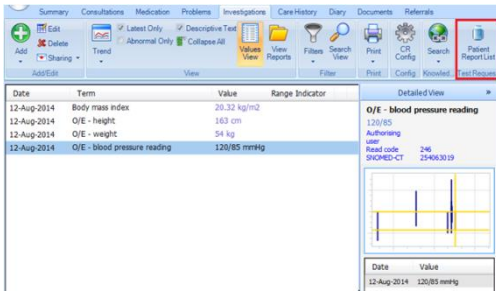

Investigations

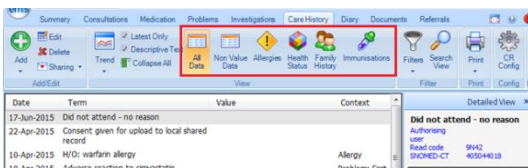
- You can view results, add, edit or delete. Highlight the result you wish to view and you will see the detailed view on the right. Click **Patient Report List** to see online test requests and results

Care History

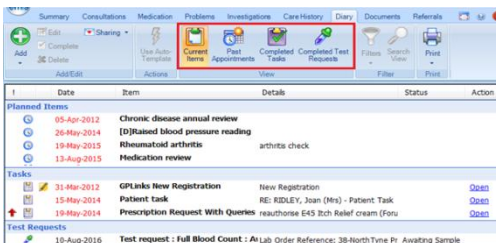

2. Here you can add, edit, and delete by highlighting and using right click options

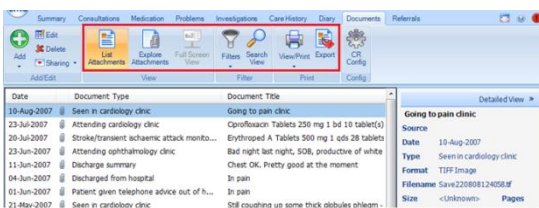
Diary
